I. Projektentstehung

Durch die näheren Gespräche die zwischen dem Kölner Generalvikariat (GV) und Holger Peter Sandhofe (HPS) bezüglich des Imprimatur zum Nocturnale Romanum (NR) geführt wurden, regten Weihbischof Dr. Nikolaus Dick (ND) und Frau Dr. Anette Söete (AS) die zusätzliche Aufnahme der Antiphonen zu den Nocturnen gemäß Liturgia Horarum (Lit. Hor.) an. Da aber aus drucktechnisch Gründen und aus Zeitmangel eine solche Arbeit nicht in Zusammenhang mit dem NR geleistet werden konnte, bot HPS eine vollständige Vertonung bzw. Restitution aller Antiphonen des Vierwochenpsalters der Lit. Hor. in einem eigenständigen Projekt an. In das NR wurde lediglich eine einseitige Tabelle der Psalmenverteilung gemäß Lit. Hor. aufgenommen.

II. Projektabsicht

a) Vorgeschichte

Aufgrund der Einführung der Lit. Hor. und deren grundsätzlich neuer Struktur, war es den römischen Stellen und den mit ihnen verbundenen Institutionen nicht geglückt, ein vollständige Antiphonale zur Lit. Hor. zu erstellen. Insgesamt drei Vorschläge der Abtei Solesmes (Frankreich) wurden im Laufe der letzten dreißig Jahre immer wieder von der Gottesdienstkongregation (Congregazione per il culto divino = CCD) abgelehnt.

b) Problematik

Die Schwierigkeiten bestehen hauptsächlich darin, daß viele der eigentlich als Gregorianik zu singenden Teile der Lit. Hor. nicht historischen Ursprunges sind und in den meisten Fällen niemals im Verlaufe der Liturgiegeschichte als Gregorianische Gesänge existiert hatten. Daraus ergeben sich nun nur drei Möglichkeiten:

1. Alle neuen „Gesangs-Texte“ werden durch historische, aber textlich anderslau-

tende in einem zukünftigen Antiphonale ausgetauscht, dadurch entsteht eine Disrepanz zwischen Lit. Hor. als Textbuch und dem Antiphonale als Gesangsbuch.

2. Diejenigen „Gesangs-Texte“ die nicht als schon historische Gregorianik vorliegen, werden neu vertont, dadurch verliere jedoch das gregorianische Œvre seinen geschlossenen historischen Wert.

3. Die Lit. Hor. müßte nach Maßstäben der vorliegenden Gregorianischen Gesänge aus historischer Zeit in ihren „musikalischen“ Teilen reformiert werden.

Eine vierte Erwägung, nämlich die, daß die Lit. Hor. zugunsten eines historischeren Brevieres wieder abgeschafft werden könnte, ist derzeit weder liturgiewissenschaftlich noch kirchenpolitisch diskutabel bzw. Erwägenswert.

c) Lösungsversuch

Um der CCD in dieser Situation einen sinnvollen Arbeitsansatz zu bieten, der eine endgültige Erstellung eines Antiphonales zur Lit. Hor. ermöglicht, soll nun wenigstens das Vierwochenschema per Annum, in dem sich die meisten unhistorischen „Gesangs-Texte“ befinden, erstellt werden.

III. Projektmethode

a) Ausgangspunkt

Bei den Gesängen zum Vierwochenpsalter kommen liturgiewissenschaftlich betrachtet zwei Gruppen vor:

1. historische Antiphonen:

- a)* schon im Vorgängerritus (tridentinisch) vorhanden.
- β)* zu irgendeinem Zeitpunkt im Laufe der Kirchengeschichte irgendwo in einem Eigenritus existent.

2. neukompilierte Texte:

- a)* nie zuvor in der Liturgie in der nun beabsichtigten liturgischen Funktion verwendet.
- β)* zufälligerweise oder absichtlich mit einem historischen

Gesang ganz oder in Teilen in der nun beabsichtigten liturgischen Funktion identisch.

Zwischen 1.β und 2.β zu unterscheiden, hieße, die Absicht oder die fachlichen Fähigkeiten der Liturgiereformer interpretieren zu wollen. Dies soll an dieser Stelle nicht geschehen.

Die historischen Antiphonen werden den Quellen entnommen und entsprechend melodisch restituiert, die neuen Antiphonen nachträglich vertont. Um jedoch liturgische Texte *gregorianisch* zu vertonen, bedarf es näherer Kenntnis der Gesetzmäßigkeiten, die dem gregorianischen Gesang strukturell zugrunde liegen. Sie können an dieser Stelle nicht erörtert werden. Verschiedene Gesangsgattungen (z.B. Responsorien, Antiphonen, Hymnen) verlangen eine jeweils eigene Art des Aufbaus, Melodik, Modalität und Melodik. In vorliegendem Falle haben wir es nur mit Antiphonen zu tun.

b) Orientierung am historischen Vorbild

Damit sich die neuvertonten Antiphonen nicht von den wenigen noch verbliebenen historischen stilistisch unterscheiden, werden den neuzuvertonenden Texten die Melodien historischer Antiphonen zugrunde gelegt. Die Auswahl der historischen Melodien für die neuen Texte richtet sich vor allem nach der formalen Textstruktur. Neue Text und anderslautender Text der historische Melodie sollten nach Möglichkeit so identisch wie Möglich sein.

Dies sind unter anderem:

1. Textmenge
2. Textstruktur
3. Syntax
4. Satz- und Worthrhythmus

Tesxtausage und Inhalt spielen keinerlei Rolle, da in der Gregorianik die Textbedeutung für eine Vertonung einer nur sehr untergeordnete Rolle spielt; und dies auch nur in Charaktergesängen wie Introitus, Offertorium, Communio einigen Groß-Responsorien und Tropen. Bei solch kleinen Stücken wie den Antiphonen zum Wochenpsalter handelt es sich eher um handwerklich schlüssige denn künstlerisch aussagestarke Werke. Die Verbindung von Wort und Ton im Choral ist mehr grammatischer als den Wortsinn wiedergebender Art. Manierismus im heutigen Sinne ist der klassischen Gregorianik gänzlich fremd!

c) historische Quellen

Die Vorlagen der historischen Melodien werden, der allgemeinen und durchaus zu rechtfertigen wissenschaftliche Meinung nach, zumeist dem Codex St. Gallen 390/391, dem sog. Codex Hartker entnommen.

d) Quellenbelege

Um die Nachweisbarkeit der Melodiefindung der neuvertonten Antiphonen zu erleichtern, ist jede Antiphon mit einer Fußnote versehen, der sich ein musikkritischer Apparat anschließt, aus dem hervorgeht, welche historische Antiphon der nun neuen Antiphon Pate stand, bzw. inwieweit textlich verwandte Antiphonen nun voneinander abweichen.

IV. Projektdiskussion

a) Internet

In Absprache mit Herrn Alexander Schweitzer, Internationale Gesellschaft für Gregorianische Studien (AISCGre), wird nach Vollendung des gesamten Vierwochenpsalters auf der Internetseite der AISCGre eine Downloadmöglichkeit dieser Vertonungen angeboten; mit dem Hinweis, daß dies nur ein Vorschlag ist, der diskutiert und von kompetenter Hand mit Verbesserungsvorschlägen bedacht werden darf.

b) Fachleute

Zudem haben sich versierte Musik- und Liturgiewissenschaftler bereit gefunden, dieses Projekt zu begleiten, bzw. bringen ihm eine aktives Interesse entgegen.

V. Projektabschluss

Nach einem ausreichenden wissenschaftlichen Diskurs soll dann eine endgültige Version als Vorschlag, nach Möglichkeit im Namen der Erzdiözese Köln oder des Liturgischen Institutes in Trier, in Rom bei der CCD eingereicht werden. Dieser Schritt aber bedarf dann noch eigens einer gründlichen Vorbereitung. Nach erfolgter Einreichung dieses musikalischen Vorschlages ist das Projekt als solches beendet und die weitere Verwendung der in diesem Vorschlag vorhandenen Antiphonen liegt bei der CCD.

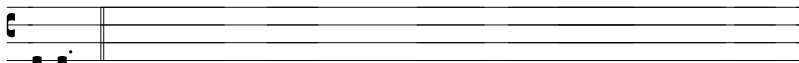

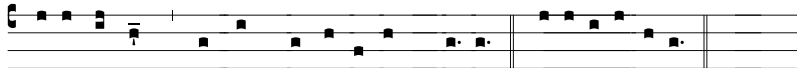
