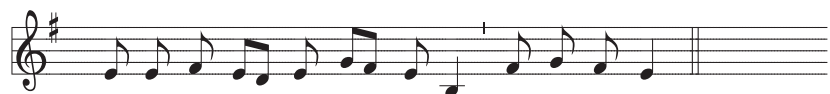


You have visited the | *land and* watered it ;

They shout and | *sing for joy*. (R)



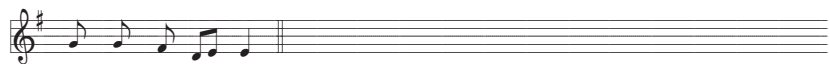

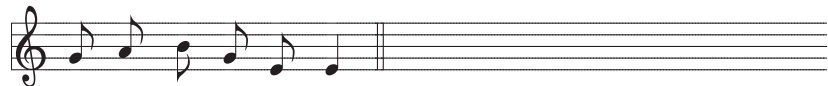
