

## SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

INTROIT

*Is 48: 20*

8. **S** Peak out with a voice of joy; \* and let it be heard to the ends of the earth: al-le-lu-ia. The Lord has set his people free, al-le-lu-ia, al-le-lu-ia.

### Psalm 65

Ps. 1 **S**hout with joy to God, all the earth, sing a psalm to his name; give glo-ry to his praise.\* *Ant. Or: praise.*

Ps. 2 **L**ET all on earth worship and sing praise to you, sing praise to your name. \* Come and see the works of God, his tre- men-dous deeds a-mong men. *Ant. Or: men.*

\* If the Introit antiphon is repeated immediately after the psalm verse, use the first ending. If more psalm verses follow, use the second ending.

Ps. 3 **O** bless our God, you peo-ples, and loud-ly sound his praise; \* he has giv-en life to our souls, and has not let our feet slip. *Ant. Or: slip.*

Ps. 4 **H**ear now, all you who fear God, while I de-clare what he has done for me. \* When I ap-pealed to him in words. *Ant. Or: words.*

Ps. 5 **G**OD has at-tend-ed to the voice of my sup-pli-ca-tion. \* Bless-ed be God, who has not turned a-way my prayer, nor his mer-cy from me. *Ant.*

all the Lord de-liv-ers him. *Ant.* If you love me.

5. **T** HE Lord redeems the lives of his ser-vants; \* no one  
in-curs guilt who takes re-fuge in him. *Ant.* If you love me.
