break forth into *joyous song*, *
and sing out *your praise*.

3. Sing psalms to the LORD *with the harp*, *
with the harp and the sound *of song*.
With trumpets and the sound *of the horn*, *
raise a shout before the King, *the LORD*.

I will offer bullocks *and* goats.

To him I *cried aloud*, *
with exaltation ready on *my tongue*.

4. Had I considered evil *in my heart*, *
the LORD would not *have listened*.
But truly *God has listened*; *
he has heeded the voice of *my prayer*.
Blest be God, who did not *reject my prayer*, *
nor withhold from me his *merciful love*.

Jn 15: 5


