


NUPTIAL MASS

Rejoice *before* him.



Psalm 31 (30)


1. Let your face shine on *your* servant. *






B Lessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see




God; * blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called

Psalm 37 (36)

then you will dwell in the land and *safely pasture*.
Better the few possessions *of the just*, *
than the abundant wealth *of the wicked*.

2. The LORD takes note of the days *of the blameless*; *
their heritage will *last forever*.

They shall not be put to shame in *evil days*; *
in time of famine they shall *have their fill*.

By the LORD are the *steps made firm* *
of one in whose path *He delights*.

3. Then turn away from evil *and do good*, *
and you may *abide forever*;

for indeed, the LORD *loves justice*, *
and will never forsake *his faithful*.

4. The unjust shall be wiped *out forever*, *
and the descendants of the wicked *destroyed*.

The just shall inherit *the land*; *
there they shall *abide forever*.

Then wait for the LORD, keep *to his way*. *
He will exalt you to inherit *the land*.
