Celebrant alone

To you, therefore, most merciful Father, we make humble prayer and petition through Jesus Christ, your Son, our Lord:

He joins his hands and says:

that you accept

He makes the Sign of the Cross once over the bread and chalice together, saying:

and bless
♣ these gifts, these offerings,

With hands extended he continues:

these holy and unblemished sacrifices, which we offer you firstly for your holy catholic Church. Be pleased to grant her peace, to guard, unite and govern her throughout the whole world, together with your servant N. our Pope and N. our Bishop,* and all those who, holding to the truth, hand on the catholic and apostolic faith.

AUGUST 8 Holy Father Dominic, Priest Solemnity

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON In the midst of the Church he opened his mouth, and the Lord filled him with the spirit of wisdom and understanding and clothed him in a robe of glory.	Cf. Sir 15 :5 [MLOP 198 / MR 943 / MR3 939]
Or: How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings glad tidings of peace, bearing good news, announcing salvation.	Cf. Is 52 :7 [MLOP 198 / MR 940 / MR3 936]
Or: My covenant with him was a covenant of life and peace. True instruction was in his mouth; He walked with me in peace and uprightness.	Cf. Mal 2 : 5a, 6 [MLOP 198]
The Gloria in excelsis (Glory to God in the highest) is said.
