Thou hast made known to me the ways of life, thou shalt fill me with joy with thy countenance, O Lord. 1. Preserve me, O Lord, for I have put my trust in thee. 2. I have said to the Lord, thou art my God, for thou hast no need of my goods. 3. To the saints, who are in his land, he hath made wonderful all my desires in them. 4.
