Rejoice ye before him, who is the father of orphans, and the judge of widows; God in his holy place. 4. Thou hast ascended on high, thou hast led captivity captive; thou hast received men as tribute, yea those also that rebel, into the dwelling of the Lord God. 5. Blessed be the Lord day by day; the God of our salvation who bears us up. 6. Our God is the God of salvation; and of the Lord, of the Lord are the issues from death. 7. They have seen thy goings, O God, the goings of my God, of my king who is in his sanctuary. 8. Command thy strength, O God; confirm, O God, what thou hast wrought in us. 9. From thy temple in Jerusalem kings shall offer presents to thee. 10. Sing to God, ye kingdoms of the earth, sing ye to the Lord; sing ye to God, who mounteth above the heaven of heavens, to the east; behold he will give to his voice the voice of power.
